



Nevada Health Link State Based Exchange Platform

How to Enroll in a Qualified Dental Plan ONLY

1. Overview

This Fact Sheet is intended to provide a detailed step-by-step description of the enrollment and application process for Nevada consumers interested in applying for Qualified Dental Plans (QDP) through Nevada Health Link's State Based Exchange (SBE) Platform.

<u>Please note</u>: If you are Medicare-eligible (65+) and are interested in a QDP, the SBE platform allows consumers to purchase a QDP *without* purchase of a Qualified Health Plan (QHP).

2. Important Steps for your Dental Coverage Application

Your Dental Coverage Application on the Nevada Health Link SBE Platform will ask if you need any help paying for your dental coverage, in the "Help Paying for Coverage" section. Please select option "No."



You will see the "Information About Medicare" pop-up box in the "About Your Household" section that will say, "If you have Medicare, you cannot enroll in Exchange coverage." Ignore the box and click on "Ok" to continue with your application.

3. Steps to Enroll in A Dental Plan

Complete your Dental Coverage Application! Follow these steps to enroll in a Qualified Dental Plan on Nevada Health Link SBE Platform:

- Step-1: Go to 'My Dashboard' and click the 'Shop for Plans' button.
- Step-2: Ignore the "Hardship Exemption" step and click 'Save and Continue'.
- Step-3: Click on "Shop Dental Plans" tab, select the household members whom you want to enroll and click on 'Shop Dental Plans'.
- Step-4: Select the plan of your choice from the list and click 'Add'.
- Step-5: A pop-up box will appear. Click 'Continue To Cart', verify your plan purchase, and click 'Sign Application'.
- Step-6: Read the Enrollment Terms and Conditions, check the Exchange Agreement attestation box, provide e-signature, and click 'Sign and Enroll'.
- Step-7: Click the 'Pay for Dental Insurance' button. Congratulations, you have successfully enrolled in a Qualified Dental Plan on the Nevada Health Link SBE Platform.
