About Nevada Health Link

- Nevada's Official Health Insurance Marketplace.
- NevadaHealthLink.com is operated by the state agency, the Silver State Health Insurance Exchange.
- We connect Nevadans who are not insured by their employer, Medicaid, or Medicare to comprehensive health insurance coverage.
- Individuals can purchase Affordable Care Act certified Qualified Health Plans or Qualified Dental Plans through the Exchange. If eligible, they can receive subsidy assistance to help offset monthly premium costs.
- NevadaHealthLink.com is THE ONLY place Nevadans can get access to financial assistance for their health or dental coverage.
- Solely self-funded no state and limited federal funds to support operations.

2024 Enrollment

Plan Year 2024's enrollment numbers outpaced last year's totals by 3%. This makes for the second-largest enrollment in the state's marketplace history, with 99,312 Nevadans enrolling in a Qualified Health Plan and 20,984 enrolling in a Qualified Dental Plan.

Nevada's Uninsured Landscape

- Before the pandemic, the Guinn Center conducted a study that showed an estimated 350,000 400,000 or nearly 14% Nevadans were uninsured.
- Of those uninsured:
 - 37% were thought to be Medicaid/CHIP eligible
 - 19% were thought to be Exchange eligible with financial assistance (77K)
 - 12% were thought to be ineligible for exchange financial assistance because they had offer of affordable ESI.
 - 27% were ineligible for Exchange/Medicaid due to immigration status
 - 5% were ineligible for financial assistance because of income over 400% FPL (20K), but these consumers may now qualify for financial assistance due to ARPA subsidy increases
 - The United States Census Bureau recently did an uninsured study, reporting Nevada's current uninsured rate is 11.6%

DACA Eligibility Rule Change

- On May 2, 2024, CMS finalized a rule that expanded access to health care by allowing Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals (DACA) recipients to be considered "lawfully present" with respect to enrollment eligibility for ACA Qualified Health and Dental plans.
- The final rule allowed DACA recipients to enroll in QHPs and QDPs with coverage beginning December 1, 2024.
- On August 8, 2024, a group of 19 state attorneys general filed a lawsuit in federal district court in North Dakota, seeking an injunction to block the implementation of this rule. Oral arguments were scheduled to be heard on October 15, and a ruling is likely to come shortly thereafter.
- The Exchange has implemented the functionality required by the rule change, beginning with Special Enrollment Period applications submitted during November 2024, for coverage beginning December 1, 2024.
- In the event that an injunction is granted following oral arguments, the Exchange will have the ability to revert the DACA-related changes to ensure compliance with the ruling.

Nov. 1, 2024 - Jan. 15, 2025.

Consumers who enroll thru Dec. 31, 2024, will have a coverage start date of Jan. 1, 2025.

Consumers who enroll from Jan. 1 – Jan. 15, they will have a coverage start date of Feb. 1, 2025. Consumers who completed their application but haven't selected a plan by Jan 15th will be able to complete their enrollment between January 16-21, 2025.

- A total of 18 Dental Plans will be available through five insurance carriers including: Alpha Dental, Best Life, Delta Dental, EMI Health, and Anthem Blue Cross Blue Shield (Rocky Mountain)
- 141 QHP Plans 8 Health Carriers
- The final average rate increase on-Exchange is 6.55%.

2025 Renewals

- We anticipate that nearly 99% of 2024 enrollees will be autorenewed for Plan Year 2025.
- 2024 enrollees will be renewed into their existing plan, or crosswalked into a similar plan, by October 21st.
- Consumers will have renewal notices have been delivered. Eligibility notices will be delivered within the following 48 hours.
- We always encourage existing enrollees to shop the market there are new plans and new rates for Plan Year 2025!



Advertising, Marketing & Outreach

- Leading with the core brand of Nevada Health Link, this campaign drives brand awareness and brand recognition by making the link the central focus of the messaging and visual approach. With approachable and inviting language like "Your Link to Saving," the campaign connects Nevadans to the Nevada Health Link brand in new ways.
- We aim to pay special attention to underserved communities

 be that ethnic minorities, individuals living in Rural Nevada, etc.
- We will utilize a layered media approach.
- Traditional (TV) ad campaign, outdoor, print media, content media (social, paid social, vid/GIF) and digital media.

- PR and the Media press conference will take place on Nov. 1 in Las Vegas, NV.



Updated Lock-out Feature

As part of our ongoing efforts to strengthen system security and protect user data, we are implementing two new security measures for Brokers and Navigators:

1. Enhanced Password Protection

To safeguard against unauthorized access in the Nevada Health Link platform, stricter password policies have been introduced. Effective immediately:

- After three consecutive incorrect password attempts, your account will be locked for 30 minutes.
- If three incorrect attempts are made again within a 12-hour period after the initial lockout, the lockout period will increase to 60 minutes.
- We recommend using the **password reset functionality** after **two failed login attempts** to avoid being locked out.
- 2. DUO Multi-Factor Authentication (MFA) (Impacts Brokers and Navigators)

In addition to password protection, we will be implementing Duo Multi-Factor Authentication (MFA) for **Brokers and Navigators**.

PHE Medicaid Unwinding

- August of 2024 marked the final month of Nevada's Unwinding of the Public Health Emergency (PHE).
- Approximately 129,000 Nevadans were referred to the Exchange following a loss of Medicaid/CHIP eligibility during the unwinding period, which began in May of 2023.
- The Exchange implemented a comprehensive outreach campaign, including outbound calls and an SMS messaging campaign, reaching every impacted household with a valid phone number on file.
- Of the individuals who lost Medicaid/CHIP eligibility, approximately 4,900 subsequently enrolled in health coverage through the Nevada Health Link marketplace.

Challenges for 2025 Enrollment

- Unwinding of the Public Health Emergency
 - Potential uninsured increases
- Misleading websites
 - Important to advise consumers about potential risks of short-term, limited duration plans
- Economic Challenges

Answering Open Enrollment FAQ's:

"When can I enroll?"

November 1 - January 15. Outside this period, you can only enroll with a qualifying life event.

"How do I enroll in health insurance? You can enroll in health insurance using the self-service option on our website at

enroll.nevadahealthlink.com. Additionally, we offer free enrollment assistance through licensed enrollment professionals. Or you can give us a call at 800-547-2927.

"Did I miss the Open Enrollment deadline?"

Open Enrollment begins November 1st. If you need insurance now, life events like losing coverage, moving, or changes in family size may qualify you for a Special Enrollment Period (SEP).

"Why Nevada Health Link?"

Nevada Health Link is the only place where you can access financial help to help pay for your health insurance. All our plans are Qualified Health Plans, ensuring they meet essential health coverage standards.

"Who Uses Nevada Health Link?"

Nevada Health Link is ideal for Nevadans who don't have health insurance through their employer and don't qualify for Medicaid or Medicare. We believe everyone deserves access to quality health coverage - no matter your income or family size.
